Witness the legacy of oral history, archaeological discoveries, outstanding works of art and unique artifacts that depict the ancient and modern history of our spectacular region. The museum offers a full range of seasonal programming from May to September. Daily tours of the museum and performances at the Tsimshian Longhouse all bring the history of the Northwest Coast region alive. Another highlight of the museum is the Carving House. Tsimshian, Haida, Nisga'a and Gitksan carvers work here between the months of June and August.
