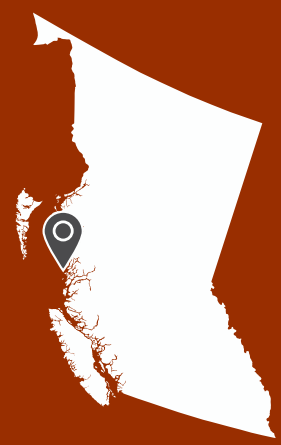


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SPIRIT BEAR LODGE

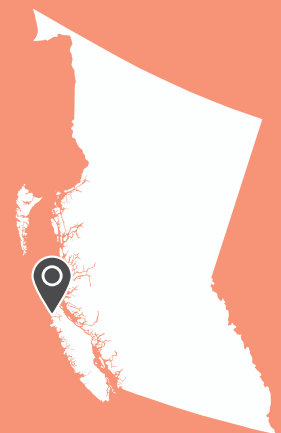

Hear stories, scrape hides, learn to bead, play traditional games, visit hot springs, and other historical locations. And for one night, guests will also sleep in traditional tipis.





AINSWORTH HOT SPRINGS RESORT

Ainsworth Hot Springs Resort lies in the traditional home lands of the Ktunaxa (pronounced 'K-too-nah-ha') people. Since time immemorial the Ktunaxa people have utilized this site as a place for healing. After battle, warriors would soak in the spirit waters (nupika wu'u) to ease the wounds sustained in the fight to defend this beautiful territory. Nestled into the mountain side along the shores of Kootenay Lake, these hot springs have been good medicine for many years. We invite you to visit soon and experience the power of nature.


